



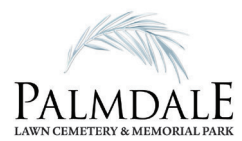
Chapel requirements for Audio Visual

The Palmdale Group has modern audio visual systems in all our chapels which will be operated by a chapel attendant on the day of the funeral service.

Video, PowerPoint and music files can be played through either a CD player, DVD player or on an Apple MacBook Pro, using either Windows Media Player, QuickTime or Apple iTunes.

We strongly recommend you book a time at the appropriate location to test your audio/visual, to ensure there are no issues on the day of the funeral service.

Testing at least the day prior will allow time for any amendments you might like to make.
